Steve Bohannon convened the General Meeting at 6:20 PM. 14 members and guests were present. Everyone welcomed guests Sam & Sheila Wylinski.

Minutes: There was no General membership meeting in December meeting therefore there were no minutes to be posted.

Treasurer's Report: Ernie Martinez reported the treasury has a balance of \$4,117.39. A summary of income and expenses is attached. The annual report is due and will cost \$65 if filed prior to 5/1/09. If filed after that date there is a \$400 late fee.

To date there is a total of 56 members which includes 1 honorary member, 41 renewals, & 14 new members.

Terry also informed everyone that in the past they have given out tickets with a specific time on them for the factory tours, and advised that there will be lots of activities at the museum with many Corvette vendors on hand. He will have more information for us soon and it will be posted on the "Corvette Corner".
